

CCTV Public Notice

Following consultation with the staff and board of the Suzanne Aubert Compassion Centre, Harbour City Security Ltd has assisted the Centre to install crime prevention cameras in:

- Reception
- Goods Entrance corridor
- Inside the Goods Entrance, facing the kitchen
- Outside the Goods Entrance, facing the carpark
- Next door on Haining St, facing the carpark

This notice is to keep the community informed about the operation and purpose of the camera system.

The area is marked with signs displaying "CCTV area".

The purpose of the cameras is to deter and capture evidence of criminal offences committed at the Centre; and to allow staff to respond quickly to incidents between guests that may occur in the carpark area prior to the opening of the waiting room.

The initiative is intended to improve safety and security at the Centre in which assaults, vandalism and burglaries have been found to be a problem.

The project is under the control of the Manager and the cameras are being monitored at the Centre. Only the Manager, and persons authorised by the Manager, will have access to the monitors or the recordings that are made.

There will be annual evaluation of the operation and effectiveness of the camera system. The next annual evaluation is **7 January 2012**.

Camera operation is being carried out in accordance with the Centre's CCTV policies which are available at Reception. All Centre policies are in compliance with the Privacy Act 1993.
